We need for it:

- Construction material: wood, awnings, cement, bricks, doors and windows, sanitation
- Furniture: desks, blackboards, chairs and tables ...
- School supplies: Books, notebooks, pencils, chalk, pens, equipment computer, projector, screen, stereo ...
- Human resources: local construction professional, local teachers.
